



Traveling Oak Leaf Luggage Tag

Skill Level: Intermediate
Yarn Weight: #3

MATERIALS

- Sport weight yarn
- (2) Size 5-7 US (3.75mm-4.5mm) needles
- (4) small stitch holders, yarn needle

GAUGE

- not critical for this project

STITCH GLOSSARY

p2sso pass 2 slipped sts over

Sp2p Slip 1 st kwise, P2tog, pass slipped st over just made st

Sk2p slip 1 st kwise, K2tog, pass slipped st over just made st

5 Stitch I-CORD

CO 5 sts. *K5, do not turn, sl sts back to LH nld; rep from * until cord meas desired length.

PATTERN

Leaf Stem

Leaving an 8" tail of yarn, CO 5 sts. Work 5 Stitch I-Cord until piece meas 1 1/4".

Body of Leaf

Row 1 (RS): K1, m1, (K1, yo) twice, K1, m1, K1 [9 sts].

Row 2 and all WSRs unless otherwise noted: Purl.

Rows 3, 13, & 23: (K3, yo) twice, K3 [11 sts].

Rows 5, 15, & 25: K3, yo, K5, yo, K3 [13 sts].

Rows 7 & 17: K3, yo, K7, yo, K3 [15 sts].

Rows 9 & 19: K3, yo, K9, yo, K3 [17 sts].

Rows 11 & 21: K8, yo, K1, yo, K3. Place next 5 sts onto stitch holder [14 sts rem].

Rows 12 & 22: P9. Place next 5 sts onto stitch holder [9 sts rem].

Row 27: Ssk, K1, yo, K2tog, K3, ssk, yo, K1, K2tog [11 sts].

Row 29: Ssk, yo, K2tog, k3, ssk, yo, K2tog [9 sts].

Row 31: Ssk, yo, K2tog, k1, ssk, yo, K2tog [7 sts].

Row 33: Ssk, yo, sl 2tog kwise, K1, p2sso, yo, K2tog [5 sts].

Row 35: K1, sl 2tog kwise, K1, p2sso, K1 [3 sts].

Row 36: Sp2p [1 st].

Fasten off.

Left Side Leaf Tips

With RS facing, place sts from upper left stitch holder onto needle. Join yarn.

Row 1: Knit.

Rows 2 & 4: Purl.

Row 3: Ssk, K1, K2tog [3sts].

Row 5: Sk2p [1 st].

Fasten off.

Rep as for sts on lower left stitch holder.

Right Side Leaf Tips

With WS facing, place sts from upper right stitch holder onto needle. Join yarn.

Rows 1 & 3: Purl.

Row 2: Ssk, K1, K2tog [3 sts].

Row 4: Sk2p [1 st].

Fasten off.

Rep as for sts on lower right stitch holder.

FINISHING

Thread I-Cord yarn tail onto yarn needle. Sew stem to WS of leaf, allow a large enough I-Cord loop to slide the strap of the luggage tag through. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

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
